All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors

(Because prices can vary).

<p>PERSONALISED ATTENDED FUNERAL (<i>funeral director's charges only</i>)</p> <p>This is where family and friends have a ceremony, event, or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation. We take care of everything, including third-party arrangements:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements; liaising with all third parties; providing advice, support, and guidance throughout all aspects of the arrangements • Collecting and transporting the deceased from the place of death (<i>normally within 30 miles of the funeral director's premises</i>) into the funeral director's care • Care of the Deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will rest in our funeral parlour in either Largs, Dalry or Beith. • Choice of Coffin – see Additional Options • Viewing for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director, within office hours only (<i>with permission from client arranging the funeral</i>) • Provision of our Traditional Hearse, Staff, a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (<i>normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises</i>) 	<p>£2,100.00</p> <p>£950.00</p> <p>£350.00</p> <p>£240.00</p> <p>£ N/A</p> <p>£560.00</p>
